## **Role purpose**

To provide ethical, reliable dog training using positive reinforcement in helping, advising and training owners to get the best from their dogs. All breeds are catered for.

## Responsibilities

- Set up venue ready for ringcraft classes and KDT shop
- Welcome clients to classes
- Promote KDT products and services
- Provide ringcraft training to clients
- Stacking and freestanding of dogs, including table dogs
- Go over the dog as an examination of the dog within Kennel Club guidelines, including use of measures
- Advising clients of different shows available, such as limit, open, Champ shows, etc.
- At the end of the class, pack up equipment and KDT shop and lock up venue.
- Provide holiday and sickness cover for Russell or Sarah

An ideal candidate for this role would be someone who wants to gain further experience within the world of dog showing.

## **Qualifications, Knowledge and Experience**

- A passion for dogs
- Understanding of different dog breeds and the techniques of them being shown
- Promoting the ethos and ethics of Knightsbay Dog Training, particularly using positive reinforcement training methods
- Knowledge and understanding of using appropriate ringcraft equipment, such as leads, grooming tables, etc
- Knowledge of Kennel Club Rules and Regulations and Ring Procedures.
- Experience of dog show handling
- Excellent customer service, including verbal and physical communication
- A good understanding of mathematics and English

- Ability to use a till

- To be a dog owner or have a dog within their household
